

GPS is pretty accurate but some carriers don't get good reception. Just type in Kennolyn Huntington Lake and that should take you to us. If you're in the area, you could also refer to "Camp LaSalle" which was the former name of the property.

From the Bay Area

- Highway 99 South to Fresno
- Highway 180 East
- Highway 168 East
- Follow the signs that will direct you to Highway 168 and Huntington and Shaver Lakes.

From Los Angeles

- Highway 99 North to Fresno
- Highway 41 North (Fresno)
- Highway 168 East
- Follow the signs that will direct you to Highway 168 and Huntington and Shaver Lakes.

Once past Shaver Lake

- Drive past China Peak Resort on right (good spot for food)
- Drive past Rancheria Marina (large metal warehouse) and Lakeshore Resort (restaurant-bar-store).
- You'll go past several public camp grounds
- Watch for Kennolyn sign on your right.
- If you're at Huntington Lake Resort, you've gone too far.

Note

Driving time from Fresno is about 1-1/2 hours. There is a "back way" through Big Creek on Huntington Lake Road which is slower than Highway 168. This is a beautiful drive through amazing granite formations, up huge elevation gains (1500'), and through a windy road. We do not recommend this route on your first trip up.
